Topic: Who is God? – The One True God

Objective:

By the end of this session, students will understand key attributes of God—Creator, Love, Holy—and the core belief of God's oneness. They will learn how to describe who God is through Scripture, deepening their personal relationship with Him. Key Word: Monotheism

KEY: UNDERSTANDING "WHO IS GOD?"

1. Monotheism

Definition: The belief that there is only one God.

Scripture Reference: Deuteronomy 6:4 (NLT): *"Listen, O Israel: The Lord our God, the Lord alone."*

2. Creation

Definition: The act of God bringing the universe and everything in it into existence.

Scripture References:

- Genesis 1:1 (NLT): *"In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth."*
 - Psalm 19:1 (NLT): *"The heavens proclaim the glory of God. The skies display his craftsmanship."*

3. Spirit

Definition: The non-physical essence of God that is present everywhere.

5. Eternity

Definition: The attribute of God meaning He has no beginning or end; He exists outside of time.

Scripture References:

- Psalm 90:2 (NLT): *"Before the mountains were born, before you gave birth to the earth and the world, from beginning to end, you are God."*
 - Revelation 1:8 (NLT): *"I am the Alpha and the Omega—the beginning and the end," says the Lord God. "I am the one who is, who always was, and who is still to come—the Almighty One."*

6. Unity

Definition: The state of being one; God is not made up of parts and cannot be divided.

Scripture Reference: John 10:30 (NLT): *"The Father and I are one."*

7. Divine Nature

Definition: The intrinsic qualities and characteristics of God that reflect His perfection and holiness.

Scripture Reference: 2 Peter 1:4 (NLT): *"And because of his glory and excellence, he has given us great and precious promises. These are the promises that enable you to share his divine nature and escape the world's corruption caused by human desires."*

8. Sovereignty

Definition: The authority of God to govern and rule over all creation.

Scripture Reference: Psalm 103:19 (NLT): *"The Lord has made the heavens his throne; from there he rules over everything."*
